



About RASA

RASA – **Ramana Sunritya Aalaya** was founded in 1989 by **Dr. Ambika Kameshwar** with the vision to empower one and all, through the Theatre Arts experience. Today, RASA stands as a 34 year old organisation with a multi-pronged approach to inclusion and transformation. This could not have been achieved without the support of our Staff, Donors, Partners and Parents. By God's Grace we have been able to consistently run several activities that have created a long-term positive impact on our beneficiaries.

RASA is a unique organization which focuses on the holistic development of each individual through experiences of Music, Dance, Drama, Story-Telling and other aspects of Theatre. **This innovative methodology** used to foster Holistic Development is called **Theatre Arts for Holistic Development** (**TAHD**).

Ambika Kameshwar, the founder of RASA, developed Theatre Arts for Holistic Development (TAHD), and after intensive research and successful application. Theatre Arts for Holistic Development uses creative arts like Dance, Music, Drama, Story-telling and Art and Craft as tools of learning. In our three Theatre Arts Learning Centres located in Thiruvanmiyur, Greenways Road, Chennai and Aadharan, Bangalore, we have approached learning and teaching innovatively by following means;

- Providing Indian Theatre Arts without disparity to one and all through **outreach programmes** and build **Theatre Art Learning Centres** which promotes performance training performances.
- Enabling individuals to realize their potential through **Theatre Arts Learning Centres** which facilitate self-exploration and holistic development.
- Developing Livelihood Division in which children are made to become independent individuals which in turn boosts their self confidence.
- Creating Theatre Arts for Holistic development (TAHD) professionals through **PG Diploma**, Workshops and Short-term training programmes.
- Facilitating development of TAHD methodology through **Research and Documentation**

We at RASA through Theatre Arts for Holistic Development program using the different aspects of theatre to promote **holistic development** in children. TAHD is based on the belief that theatre can be used to help children develop their **physical**, **emotional**, **social**, **and cognitive skills**. The program uses a variety of activities, including dance, music, mime, drama, and arts and crafts, to create a fun and engaging learning environment.

RASA – OUT REACH





Through the outreach programme RASA reaches out to special schools in Chennai once a week. Keeping in mind the specific need of the children the session plans are designed to address independent goals like improving attention span, group cohesiveness, expression of emotions, social behavior etc. As a fruition of the inputs and training given, the students are given opportunities to perform, share their experiences and showcase their talents on several performance platforms.

Theatre is all about reclaiming our innate capacity as human beings for creative experiences of an individual and collective human experience in an artistic form.

It helps integrate mind body and spirit holistically.

As part of the varied activities of rasa in spreading and reaching out through the methodology of TAHD, the outreach programme is an integral part of the organization. Several special schools have benefitted by the weekly theatre classes by RASA's facilitators. For the adult group the focus is on body and spatial awareness, sequential movement, and increased communication skills. Values were taught through drama and story. Training them for stage performance was also the focus.

For the younger children also, RASA always keeps in mind the specific needs of the children the sessions are designed to address independent goals. Performance training is also imparted.

The children are trained and seamlessly integrated into RASA's Annual Day to perform along with the other differently abled students.

As more awareness spreads about the methodology and the organization one would wish for more students to benefit from the magic of theatre.

The feedback from the schools has been rewarding. The teachers feel that these children after a TAHD session are able to settle down and focus better in the class.

Theatre Arts Learning Centres

Dr. Ambika Kameshwar has created a methodology called **Theatre Arts for Holistic Development** which focuses on the overall empowerment of one and all.

RASA has three centres facilitating life skills training in Chennai and has a centre at Bangalore as well.



All the centres focus on life skills development through the tools of Indian Theatre. Education as well as life skills training is imparted to the adults with differing abilities and the modules are individual specific.

The community served by RASA ranges from toddlers to senior adults with differing abilities. There are around 70 full time differently abled students in RASA

We have a set of trained staff who take care of each student's progress on a periodic basis.

RASA LIVELIHOOD UNITS



We at RASA aim to provide self-confidence and independence to people with differing abilities by empowering them with relevant skills and help them live their best lives.

The focus of the Livelihood Division is to provide special employment opportunities for youth and persons with differing abilities and enable them to become economically independent through specialized training.

RASA picks out students trainable in Arts and Crafts to make products such as jewellery, trays, file folders, photo frames, bags and several other products, and provides a stipend to these special artisans.







RASA ONLINE CLASS

RASA has slowly started preparing to call in the special students for physical classes. A hybrid model is being worked out for the same.

Online classes, will however continue as we are able to reach many young students with differing abilities across the globe.


























RASA – AADHARAN Bangalore Centre



Located on Bengaluru's bustling Sampige Road in Malleshwaram is the truly unique Rasa Aadharan, a centre for children and adults with special needs. Committed to the holistic development of special students, Rasa Aadharan is a branch of RASA, Chennai.



For the uninititated, TAHD refers to a methodology of using fine arts like dance, drama, music and Storytelling in the rehabilitation programme. TAHD is based on the underlying principle that each person has an inherent sense of rhythm, movement and dramatic skills that can be tapped and channelized in order that they realize their complete potential. This method is especially effective in people with special needs as it is scientifically structured to meet their needs. Complimented with the use of various therapeutic techniques like physiotherapy, speed therapy and psychotherapy, TAHD is known to help such individuals achieve and improve their optimum level of functioning.







At Aadharan new students were enrolled in June and the first month was a period of observation during which the special requirements of the students were studied and a structured plan put in place. This also include a visit to the homes of the students so that no important information was missed out. All lesson plans and activities chalked our for the year were vetted by RASA.

Once the students settled in, they engaged in all sorts of activities that were planned in such a way that they became aware of not only the minds and bodies but also their capabilities. A typical day in RASA Aadharan starts with a prayer and a session of physical movements including yoga. The morning session has music, dance or drama sessions. Each day is unique and has a mix of different activities. The warm up and yoga sessions are aimed at developing flexibility, concentration and body control. While dance and movements sessions help in improving mobility, music helps in honing listening skills and also in grasping number concepts. Drama greatly aids in developing social and emotional skills. Story, script and dialogue facilitate speech development and reading and writing skills.

Other activities

In the last year, Aadharan included a number of fun activities once a month on a Saturday like fancy dress, rangoli and cooking competitions. "The whole idea is to make the students feel empowered and do something on their own while learning. For Instance, we taught them the concept of colours during the Rangoli competition and for the cooking day, we had the students shop for all the materials on their own and actually cook by themselves. The focus is on functional academics," adds Rupa. They have also earned the unique distinction of participating in a cultural event organized by Ranjani Kala Kendra wherein they created a Guinness World Records for 100 hours of non-stop cultural programme at Freedom Park, Bengaluru.





RASA - A.R.P.I.T.A.

(Academy for Research and Performance of Indian Theatre Arts)



Classes in structured dance and music is taught at RASA - ARPITA (Academy for Research and Performance of Indian Theatre Arts) since 1985.

Regular classes in Structured Dance (Bharatanatyam) and Carnatic Classical Music were conducted as the main activity of RASA ARPITA.

Classes were taken regularly online and at RASA Greenways Raod, Chennai.

Sloka Classes are taken for young children who are interested to learn about our Indian Culture and Heritage.



Classes in Indian Cultural Heritage



Sri G. Kameshwar covers rare stories from the Mahabharata from the Adi Parva and Sabha Parva to a select consistent audience in the virtual mode.




RASA CULTURAL CENTRE
