



## **ABOUT OUR ORGANISATION - RASA**



RASA – Ramana Sunritya Aalaya was founded in 1989 by Dr. Ambika Kameshwar as a non-profit cultural organization with the objective of promoting awareness of the rich Indian Cultural Heritage, through the media of Classical Dance, Music, Drama and other dance forms. Our unique purpose has been to reach out to those who have hitherto been deprived of experiencing the art forms and has included in its cultural ambience people with special needs.

Today, RASA stands as a 32 year old organisation with a multi-pronged approach to inclusion and transformation. This could not have been achieved without the support of our Staff, Donors, Partners and Parents. By God's Grace we have been able to consistently run several activities that have created a long-term positive impact on our beneficiaries.

Rasa has conducted Cultural festivals, workshops, and competitions, under the title Language of Dance. Eminent Artistes from all over India have participated, presenting various styles of classical dance, in the form of Lecture Demonstrations and performances delineating a specific theme.

Over the years RASA has presented several Dance Theatre productions with its senior artistes such as Shankara Vijayam, Mahamaham, Thyagaraja Ramayanam,Sitayah Charitam Mahat, Svatantriyam Sarvam Brahma Mayam, Ekameva, Bharati Kanda Shakthi & Amrapali. Some of them have been supported by the Dept of Culture Ministry of HRD as well.

RASA Centre for Theatre Arts and Special Needs, is in the service of Children with various Disabilities, and uses Theatre arts as tools for their rehabilitation. Special children and adults get training in different aspects of theatre like music, dance, art, storytelling and drama. Children and adults learn about life using Theatre Arts as tools. We take great pride every year in presenting these children in a unique cultural events of Music, Dance and Drama providing an opportunity of complete development through Theatre to one and all. Transcending all barriers, - to explore, to enjoy and experience the various art forms as 'No handicap to dance' – is Our RASA DAY Motto. RASA organizes a mega show every year involving over 200 artistes with differing abilities.

RASA has done several productions with the support of the Ministry of Culture, Government of India.

### **Theatre Arts Learning Centres**

Theatre arts can be used as a tool to empower any individual to his / her highest potential.

Dr. Ambika Kameshwar has created a module called theatre arts for Holistic development which focuses on overall empowerment of one and all.

There are around 80+ full time differently abled students in RASA.

We have a set of trained staff who take care of each student's progress in a periodic basis.

### RASA LIVELIHOOD UNITS



We at RASA aim to provide self-confidence and independence to people with differing abilities by empowering them with relevant skills and help them live their best lives.

The focus of the Livelihood Division is to provide special employment opportunities for youth and persons with differing abilities and enable them to become economically independent through specialized training. Various craft items like trays, beaded cell phone pouches, embroidered materials, screen and printed bags, are produced in this unit

RASA has slowly started preparing to call in the special trainees for physical classes. A hybrid model is being worked out for the same.


Online classes, will however continue as we are able to reach many young trainees with differing abilities across the globe.

### RASA – A.R.P.I.T.A.

#### (Academy for Research and Performance of Indian Theatre Arts)



Classes in structured dance and music is taught at RASA - ARPITA (Academy for Research and Performance of Indian Theatre Arts) since 1985.

Regular classes in Structured Dance (Bharatanatyam) and Carnatic Classical Music were conducted as the main activity of RASA ARPITA.

Classes were taken regularly online and at RASA Greenways Raod, Chennai.

#### **RASA – OUT REACH**



Through the outreach programme RASA reaches out to special schools in Chennai once a week. ### Classes in Indian cultural heritage




Our country is rich in its Culture and Heritage. RASA feels blessed to preserve and spread awareness about our rich Indian culture and heritage through regular classes in Ramayana And Mahabharata by Sri G Kameshwar and Vedanta sharing by Dr Ambika Kameshwar.

Sri G Kameshwar covered rare stories from the Mahabharata from the Adi Parva and Sabha Parva to a select consistent audience in the virtual mode.

Dr Ambika Kameshwar shared insights from the Bhagavad Gita and how those values can be applied in our daily life.

These classes which has its focus on education and information on the Indian Cultural Heritage Awareness and Experience are conducted by G Kameshwar does extensive research and shares his vast knowledge on the Ramayana by Poet Valmiki. Mr. Kameshwar not only shares descriptively the story of Ramayana but also simultaneously quotes from a lot of other Sanskrit and Tamil literature and spiritual texts.

## RASA – AADHARAN Bengaluru Centre



Located on Bengaluru's bustling Sampige Road in Malleshwaram is the truly unique Rasa Aadharan, a centre for children and adults with special needs. Committed to the holistic development of special students, Rasa Aadharan is a branch of RASA, Chennai.



For the uninititated, TAHD refers to a methodology of using fine arts like dance, drama, music and Storytelling in the rehabilitation programme. TAHD is based on the underlying principle that each person has an inherent sense of rhythm, movement

and dramatic skills that can be tapped and channelized in order that they realize their complete potential. This method is especially effective in people with special needs as it is scientifically structured to meet their needs. Complimented with the use of various therapeutic techniques like physiotherapy, speed therapy and psychotherapy, TAHD is known to help such individuals achieve and improve their optimum level of functioning.



At Aadharan new students were enrolled in June and the first month was a period of observation during which the special requirements of the students were studied and a structured plan put in place. This also include a visit to the homes of the students so that no important information was missed out. All lesson plans and activities chalked our for the year were vetted by RASA.

Once the students settled in, they engaged in all sorts of activities that were planned in such a way that they became aware of not only the minds and bodies but also their capabilities. A typical day in RASA Aadharan starts with a prayer and a session of physical movements including yoga. The morning session has music, dance or drama sessions. Each day is unique and has a mix of different activities. The warm up and yoga sessions are aimed at developing flexibility, concentration and body control. While dance and movements sessions help in improving mobility, music helps in honing listening skills and also in grasping number concepts. Drama greatly aids in developing social and emotional skills. Story, script and dialogue facilitate speech development and reading and writing skills.



### RASA WEB CHANNEL

"Unifying through the Artistic Experience", being the vision of RASA, it introduces the Rasa Web Channel as one of its facets. Rasa Web Channel is a pure culture channel that provides multifarious cultural programs for the benefit, entertainment and selfupliftment of people around the world. The audience can enjoy, relax and learn from various content rich cultural programs anytime and anywhere, free of cost. It is also a unique online platform that encourages the people around the world to participate and share their talents in various art forms to promote themselves and support a social cause.

> Paattu Class

Rasa Web Channel telecast episodes of Paattu classes taught by Dr. Ambika Kameshwar. The show projects online classes for music trainers to learn different Carnatic songs. It guides the learner to understand and practice the songs in a proper manner.

### > Ramayanam

The story of Ramayana is being explained by Mr.G Kameshwar. A structured storyline is being projected to the listeners through slokas and the narrations are done in such a way that different aspects of the Ramayana is brought out.

#### > Isai Perurai

The episodes of Isai Perurai- A Musical Discourse by Dr. Ambika Kameshwar enhances both divinity and current scenarios related to life lessons. The show brings in inner peace and journey that a listener wish to seek through Music and Religious stories.

### > A Tribute to my Guru

The Episode showcases young budding dancerssharing their moments of the journey of their Arangetram along with the snippets of their Arangetram.

#### > Padi Varum Pookal

The Episode provides opportunities for young budding musicians to showcase their talent in a global platform.

#### Ramana Rasanubhayam

This show is produced by Ramana Maharshi Centre for Learning Bengaluru, showcases various speakers who share important life lessons from the teachings of Bhagavn Sri Ramana Maharshi.

#### > Interview of Senior Artistes

The web channel telecast Interviews of Legendary Gurus, interviewed by Dr. Divyasena on behalf of Rasa Web Channel. It explores methodologies and experiences gained by the gurus in their course of learning and teaching in the past years.
